// SUPPLEMENTARY DATA

dbinfo.php
- stores handshake to access dbase style.css
- styles the "output_report_from_dbase.php" file

// PROCESSING PAGES

add_to_database.php
- table to add data

add.php
- form to add data
- interface to send data to dbase

schedule_new_data_processor.php
- inspects data input in form
- scrubs and validates for further processing

initiate_delete_record.php
- inspects the submitted schedule record
- sends instruction to delete_secure.php to inspect the submitted record
validatordelete.php (formerly delete_secure.php)
- inspects the submitted record sent from "initiate_delete_record.php"
- sends instruction to dbase to delete the submitted dbase record
- OR -
- ends the communication (by not forwarding data to be submitted, and ending the message with "die") update_validator.php
- inspects the submitted record
- sends instruction to dbase to update (change) the submitted dbase record
validate_secure.php
- inspects data from form
- inserts data into the database
